Dear Uniform Medical Conversion Plan I (UMCP I) Subscriber:

We're writing to notify you of benefit changes (below) and your monthly premiums (other side) for 2010. This is the only notice UMP will send regarding your 2010 conversion plan benefits. Please keep this letter with your *UMCP I 2009 Certificate of Coverage (COC)* as a reminder of the benefit changes listed below.

Medical Benefit Changes for 2010

- No dollar limit on chemical dependency treatment
- No limit to number of visits for outpatient mental health
- All inpatient admissions for chemical dependency or mental health treatment must be preauthorized

Prescription Drug Benefit Changes for 2010

- Not all Tier 3 (nonpreferred brand-name) drugs will require preauthorization.
- Most specialty drugs are becoming Tier 2 (preferred brand-name) drugs. For drugs moving from Tier 1 to Tier 2, instead of paying \$40 for a 30-day supply, you will pay \$175.

No New Benefits Book

Correction to the 2009 COC

We recently noted an error on page 31 of the 2009 COC. The table of prescription drug costs indicates that the copay for Tier 3 drugs purchased from Wellpartner, the network mail-order pharmacy, is \$100. This is incorrect; it should be 50% of the drug's cost, plus an ancillary charge if the drug has a generic equivalent. We apologize for this error. *See the enclosed page with corrections indicated; please keep with your 2009 COC for reference.*
