



Uniform Medical Plan Financial Reports

These reports together provide a summary of Uniform Medical Plan (UMP) expenditures versus premium contributions from employers and enrollees.

The reports are updated quarterly, adding another quarter's claims payments as well as revising the incurred claims estimates for prior quarters. The incurred claims figures for prior quarters will change because they include estimated costs for services that were received but not paid during that quarter. These estimates are revised as additional data from paid claims becomes available.

The UMP premiums are established in advance based on projected costs for each calendar year, and remain constant during that year. On the other hand, UMP claims costs tend to be lower at the beginning of the year, while enrollees pay out-of-pocket for services that apply to their calendar year deductibles. As a result, we would expect the reports to show positive balances for the first quarters of the year, which are then depleted as the year progresses.

Finally, to correspond to the risk groups used for premium rating, each of the reports is separated into three separate tables for:

- Active/non-Medicare Enrollees;
- Enrollees with Medicare Primary Coverage; and
- Total Uniform Medical Plan.

The "Active/non-Medicare Enrollee" tables include a small number of enrollees enrolled in Conversion Plans.

DEFINITIONS OF COLUMN HEADINGS

Paid During Period -- Final UMP payments during the quarter for medical and pharmacy claims, regardless of the date services were received.

Amount for Services Received in Prior Quarters -- Final UMP payments during the quarter for medical and pharmacy services received prior to the beginning of that quarter.

Estimated Amount for Services Received but not Paid during Quarter -- Estimated UMP payments for medical and pharmacy services received during the quarter but paid after that quarter ended. Estimates for a particular quarter will be revised as more claims information becomes available.

Estimated Incurred Claims -- Estimated UMP payments for medical and pharmacy claims with service dates in the applicable quarter. Includes estimated claims for services received by enrollees during the quarter but not yet paid. Incurred claims estimates for a particular quarter will be revised as more claims information becomes available.

Percent Paid thru 3/31/2009 -- Total dollars paid by UMP through 3/31/2009 for services received during the quarter, as a percent of the estimated incurred claims amount. This reflects the "completeness factors" used to derive the incurred claims estimates in this report.

DEFINITIONS OF COLUMN HEADINGS

Adult Units -- "Adult units" are used in developing Self-Insured rates, and reflect one or more children per enrollee as 0.75 units. Per adult unit per month converts totals to per single adult.

Estimated Incurred Claims -- Estimated UMP payments for medical and pharmacy claims with service dates in the applicable quarter. Includes estimated claims for services received by enrollees during the quarter but not yet paid. Incurred claims estimates for a particular quarter will be revised as more claims information becomes available.

Administrative and Other Expenses -- includes both administrative functions that are handled in-house (such as Health Care Authority staff assigned to the UMP program and related non-salary expenses), and outsourced services performed by contractors (such as claims processing). Also includes prescription drug rebates and adjustments to premium stabilization reserves.

Total Estimated Expenses -- the sum of estimated incurred claims and administrative and other expenses.

Employer and Enrollee Contributions -- based on finalized UMP risk-adjusted rates, multiplied by actual plan enrollment. Includes both estimated state (or employer) premium share, as well as enrollee premium contributions.

Excess / Deficit -- employer and enrollee contributions less total estimated expenses.
